CLASSROOM VOLUNTEERS

We need classroom volunteers to help in the following areas. Each area needs about 2 or more volunteers.

Reading Support

Flexible:

1-5x per week

Work with struggling readers (playing reading games or listening to children read) individually or in a small group setting using provided activities. Do only as much as you are comfortable.

Writing Support

Flexible:

1-4x per month

Listen to children individually read drafts of their writing assignments and provide feedback for improvement. This is an essential step in helping children progress and very difficult for a teacher to accomplish alone.

Math Support

Flexible:

1-4x per month

Play math games and practice math problems with a small group of students. Activities will initially be provided; you and your group can eventually make these decisions if you prefer.

Field Trip Volunteers

TBA:

1-4x per year

The Emanic Education program at Charlotte Islamic Education seeks to implement the following:

1. Educate students about the branches of Iman.
2. Integrate the branches across the curriculum.
3. Practice every branch individually and/or in groups.

Each week the students will be introduced to a new Emanic branch supported by verses from the Quran and hadeeths.

During the month of October the following branches will be addressed insha Allah: **Shukr** (thankfulness), **Dress Manners**, **Belief in Allha and His Messenger**, and **Knowledge**.
